PRIVATE INSTRUCTION

Starting at age 5
June 22* – August 13

* Based on teacher availability, students may begin summer lessons prior to the official summer start date of June 22. Please inquire.

Bassoon, banjo, cello, clarinet, dulcimer, electronic keyboard, flute, guitar, French horn, penny whistle, percussion, piano, recorder, saxophone, Suzuki cello, Suzuki guitar, Suzuki violin, trombone, trumpet, viola, violin, and voice.

The summer months are a wonderful time to begin a new instrument or to learn new techniques on the one you already play! With fewer outside activities demanding time, students are better able to focus on their musical studies. Scheduling of lessons during the summer is flexible allowing students to register for as many or as few lessons as desired.

Private lesson tuition:

30-minute: \$38.50 per lesson
 45-minute: \$54.00 per lesson
 60-minute: \$69.00 per lesson

Suzuki lesson tuition:

30-minute: \$43.00 per lesson*
 45-minute: \$64.00 per lesson*

*Note: There are no weekly Suzuki group lessons during the summer.

KEYS FOR KIDS®

Ages 4 – 9 years 6 weeks

Keys for Kids is the perfect musical opportunity to introduce young children to pitch training, rhythm, singing, solfège, and keyboard performance. During the summer, Keys for Kids classes give students a head start for the fall semester. Students must have a piano or keyboard at home to practice. Parent/caregiver participation is required for Mini and Kinder Keys classes. Ensemble classes meet for 30-minutes per week and have a maximum enrollment of 5. All other classes meet for 45-minutes and have a minimum enrollment of 6.

The program is designed for intermediate to advanced instrumentalists who are eager to have fun making music with others. Our program encourages harmony between the artistic disciplines, and shared experience and achievement among musicians.

MOTH CIT Program (Counselor in Training)

Ages 15 – 18 years

Students will be chosen by audition and recommendation. Ensemble coaching and opportunities to perform with MOTH faculty and students in recitals are available. CIT students will help faculty and staff in rehearsals and other activities during the day.
